MISSION MOMENTS: Universal Children's Day (November 20) - PWS&D is committed to protecting the rights of children, including the right to food that helps them grow and thrive. After violent conflict forced Kai and his family to leave their village in South Sudan, Kai showed signs of severe malnutrition. At a UN protection camp, Kai was admitted to a feeding centre that is part of a PWS&D supported nutrition treatment program with Canadian Foodgrains Bank. After two months Kai was discharged, healthier, stronger and better able to face each day while waiting for peace to be restored in South Sudan.
