MISSION MOMENTS:

Where there's a wheel, there's a way

In Saint-Marc, Haiti, three vehicles holding four nurses, a community health worker, medication and 200 kg of Nourimanba, a high calorie food that saves lives, arrive at a primary school, transforming it into a health post for the treatment of severe malnutrition. Supporting local partners through Canadian Foodgrains Bank, PWS&D is bringing care to children whose families can't afford medical expenses or the cost of travel to medical facilities. In a region where malnutrition is a leading cause of child mortality, this support is vital.



Clarifying note about 'members' and 'adherents'

Sometimes these terms can be confusing. When a person comes to Dayspring (or any Presbyterian Church in Canada congregation for that matter), you can be part one of two – actually three – descriptions. Let's start with the third one: This is the **covenant member**, which is any child, who has been baptized (being within the covenant), and who hasn't professed their faith publicly.

A **member** is a person who has professed their faith publicly, either at Dayspring, or another congregation from which they have been transferred and formally welcomed during a worship service.

Adherents are persons who haven't professed their faith publicly (yet) and who still see themselves as part of our faith community.

Members, as two examples, may vote at Annual Meetings of the congregation as well as when elders are elected.

Did you know...? We are asking for you to bring in used trimmed stamps for the Canadian Bible Society to sell to collectors and vendors which allows the society to purchase Bibles for the Canadian prison ministry. 10 lbs of stamps = 6 Bibles.

Trim/rip stamps, only from white or light envelopes (not industrial brown), about 1/4" around the stamp and place in the red coffee container on the table near the Library.

As well... we have a receptacle for used eye glasses provided by the Lions Clubs International Eyeglass Recycling Centre, which provides recycled eyewear free of charge to people in developing countries. Just put used glasses (without the case please!) or hearing aids in the receptacle. Thank you.

Young Adults, we will meet again during the week of **January 7-11** for a night of wings and socializing at Shane's place.

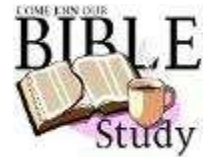

Sunday School Teachers Needed !!

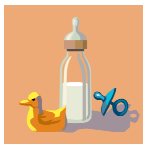
