Inspired by God's promise of abundant life, PWS&D envisions a sustainable, compassionate and just world. February 3 is PWS&D Sunday, a day to celebrate the work our church is doing to make this vision a reality, empowering people out of poverty, hunger and oppression. Today and every day, we give thanks for those striving for justice, mercy and peace throughout the world.



February 3-9 is International Development Week (IDW), a chance to celebrate Canadians who are helping reduce poverty and grow peace and opportunity in communities around the world. This year's theme "Together for Gender Equality" embodies Canada's commitment to the global effort to address gender inequality and encourages all Canadians to take part in advancing gender equality in the world. Through PWS&D, Canadians are supporting vital projects in development and relief that are promoting and advancing the rights of women and girls, ensuring girls have access to education, empowering women and girls to claim their rights, expand their livelihoods, build healthy futures and improve their prospects for the future.

Adherents are persons who haven't professed their faith publicly (yet) and who still see themselves as part of our faith community.

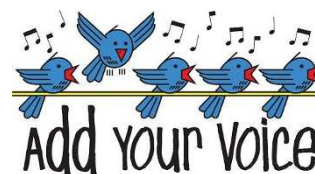
Members, as two examples, may vote at Annual Meetings of the congregation as well as when elders are elected.

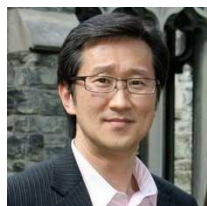

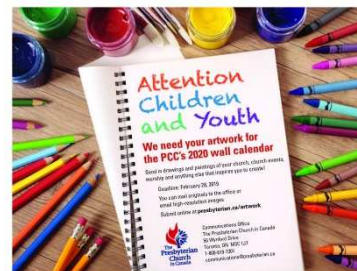
