Serving vulnerable people in Romania

Economic migration is creating challenges for people in Romania. There are over 300,000 migration orphans and a growing number of elderly people who are left behind. The good news is that they are not left alone. Diakonia Christian Foundation for Social Work of the Reformed Church in Romania reaches out to Romanian children, people living with disabilities, and the elderly. Your gifts to Presbyterians Sharing are helping to accompany and care for vulnerable people in Romania.



February 3-9 is International Development Week (IDW), a chance to celebrate Canadians who are helping reduce poverty and grow peace and opportunity in communities around the world. Adherents are persons who haven't professed their faith publicly (yet) and who still see themselves as part of our faith community.

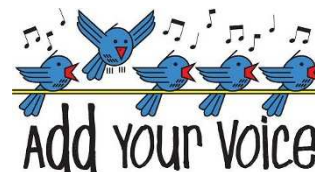
Members, as two examples, may vote at Annual Meetings of the congregation as well as when elders are elected.

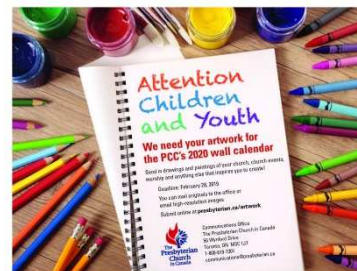
