MISSION MOMENTS: Community outreach - West Toronto's St. Andrew's Islington Presbyterian Church has begun a new missional experiment called *Intersection* that seeks to reach out to people living in their community. The church is introducing neighbours to Christ by hosting events in everyday places such as retail spaces and condo party rooms.
