### International Day of Prayer for Peace

**(September 21)** - Today, there are millions of people around the world living in conflict-affected countries. Many have been displaced from their homes and have limited access to basic needs. Children are unable to go to school. Families do not have enough food to eat. There is no telling when home might be safe again. Presbyterian World Service & Development (PWS&D) continuously provides emergency relief in conflict-affected areas. ## Neighbours helping Neighbours during this Pandemic

**A word from the Neighbourhood Care Network:** The Neighbourhood Care Network is a community collaboration between Greenfield Community Church, Enjoy Life Church and Dayspring Presbyterian Church. Together we are coordinating help to those who are in need and have been affected by the COVID-19 pandemic. This network is able to assist people who live in the Greenfield community and surrounding areas (Royal Gardens, Sweet Grass, Blue Quill), and those experiencing homelessness through our partnership with The Mustard Seed.

Since the beginning of June 2020, the Neighbourhood Care Network has involved over 40 volunteers from the partner churches and members of the local community to bake muffins, sew masks, and put together and deliver care packages to encourage those facing social isolation. Thank you to all who have given their time and talents to support our work!

The Neighbourhood Care Network has delivered over 4500 muffins and 120 reusable masks to the Mustard Seed, and provided care packages for 147 residents at the Shepherd's Care Mill Woods long-term care facility and individuals in our congregation. We have also been able to support families with meals and grocery cards. Looking towards the end of the year the Neighbourhood Care Network will continue providing muffins and masks to the Mustard Seed, as well as looking for new ways to serve our community.
