*(see below further instructions for children and youth)*

Join: Click join team. Enter: Presbytery of 'Edmonton Lakeland'. Captains last name: 'Ball'. Enter your own name and password, Choose your goal. Read and answer additional questions. Choose your challenge: Walk or Ride  
(this year we are not doing the additional activities but will look at that for another year.)
