MISSION MOMENTS: Coaching During COVID-19 - Ministry leaders had to adapt quickly to the changes brought about by COVID-19. In this new context, leaders need thoughtful, wise and prayerful approaches to ministry. In order to help PCC leaders think through and develop next steps, the PCC, with the support of funds raised through Presbyterians Sharing, offered free, one-time coaching sessions to ministry leaders.

Many ministries from across the country benefitted from this support and were able to engage in innovative ministry during a difficult time.

The Relaunch Team...At our recent Joint Board Session Meeting we decided after much discussion that we **will reopen** the church for congregational services on **November 8th**. This is, and continues to be a difficult decision. Our motion stated that all Alberta Health Services and City of Edmonton protocols will be in place. Such as that there will be **no fellowship** allowed before or after the service. All people **attending the service** will be required to **sign up** by calling the church office at 780-435-3111 by the **Thursday before**.

Do Not Attend if you any of the following symptoms: fever, cough (new cough or worsening chronic cough), shortness of breath or difficulty breathing (new or worsening), runny nose, sore throat, chills, painful swallowing, stuffy nose, headache, muscle or joint aches, feeling unwell, fatigue or severe exhaustion, gastrointestinal symptoms (nausea, vomiting, diarrhea or unexplained loss of appetite), loss of sense of smell or taste or conjunctivitis, commonly known as pink eye.

It is strongly recommended that people over 65 years of age or with chronic medical conditions do not attend.

For those that cannot or choose not to attend, we are excited that online services will still be available through Zoom. We are constantly looking for ways to improve our online presence.

Financial Update from the Board

The Board would like to thank all those that have stepped up during the last few months to generously give to the budget, our upgrades to our camera and website to allow broadcasting from our sanctuary and various other important causes. The current 2020 finances after 3 Quarters of the year looks like:

Our total Income is: \$230,585.25

Our total Expenses is: \$242,993.43


Leaving a deficit of: -\$12,408.18

Our deficit would have been \$26,562.54 if it were not for the \$14,154.36 we received from the Federal Government for COVID relief. Our rental income for the first 3 Quarters is down by \$12,971. Although some of our regular renters are back in business, a lot of our renters have decided to wait till a vaccine is available before resuming their regular activities. We feel it is important to continue to provide information about the finances of the church, especially since deficits have been part of a trend for the last few years. We ask for your prayers, and continued support during the final two months of the year. Thank you


