As a reminder there will be **no fellowship** allowed before or after the service. All people **attending the service** will be required to **sign up** by calling the church office at 780-435-3111 by the **Thursday before**.

Do Not Attend if you have any of the following symptoms: fever, cough (new cough or worsening chronic cough), shortness of breath or difficulty breathing (new or worsening), runny nose, sore throat, chills, painful swallowing, stuffy nose, headache, muscle or joint aches, feeling unwell, fatigue or severe exhaustion, gastrointestinal symptoms (nausea, vomiting, diarrhea or unexplained loss of appetite), loss of sense of smell or taste, or conjunctivitis, commonly known as pink eye.

It is strongly recommended that people over 65 years of age or with chronic medical conditions do not attend. For those that cannot or choose not to attend, we are excited that online services will still be available through Zoom. We are constantly looking for ways to improve our online presence.

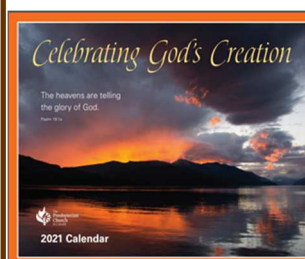
