MISSION MOMENTS: Providing Food for the Displaced - In Syria, conflict continues to plague the population, causing over six million people to become internally displaced. As a result, many people are faced with a lack of access to food, loss of employment, high prices and inflation, making them very vulnerable. COVID-19 has only exacerbated the situation. Working with partners at Canadian Foodgrains Bank, Presbyterian World Service & Development is providing food baskets to 7,400 families to help meet daily food requirements. During these times of uncertainty, the food baskets will provide a source of sustenance for the families.

Thank you to all who have been involved in the Neighbourhood Care Network over the last 7 months! Our wonderful volunteers have been key to bringing assistance and encouragement to our community. Here is a snapshot of what we have been able to accomplish this far:

- 12 000 muffins have been baked for the inner-city shelters run by the Mustard Seed
- Grocery gift cards have helped 306 people in need
- 58 people received a Christmas dinner delivered to their door
- 180 masks were hand-sewn and donated to the inner-city community
- 200 isolated seniors received care packages
- 150 teachers received an encouragement coffee voucher

Going into the New Year we are continuing to bake muffins for the Mustard Seed, and collecting donations of granola bars (nut/peanut-free), yogurt tubes and string cheese for Richard Secord Elementary School. To get involved please email ncn@greenfieldchurch.ca or visit greenfieldchurch.ca/ncn.

Also, if you are interested... one of the Greenfield Community Church ongoing projects is collecting donations of used cotton or cotton/polyester bed sheets (fitted, flat or duvet covers, any size) and/or pillowcases.
