Mission & Outreach Ministry - Update on the Neighbourhood Care Network (NCN)

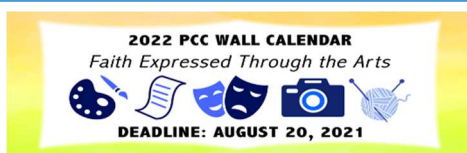
A community collaboration between DPC ~ Enjoy Life Church ~ Greenfield Church Community
