-“As a grill master and dad, you're a rare find.”

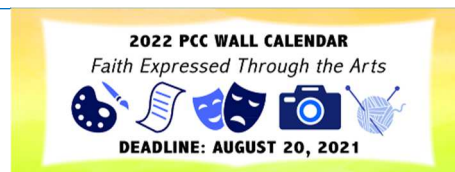
-“You can be a real pizza work, and sometimes you bacon us crazy, but we love you anyway.”
