-Please bring new mittens, hats, gloves, scarves and warm underwear to DPC and we'll decorate it with your donations!



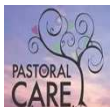
-NCN Turkey Dinners - Do you have a friend or neighbour that would enjoy a delicious turkey dinner delivered Dec 23 or 24th?
