The NCN Christmas Turkey dinner this year provided meals for 153 people in 51 homes. One of those homes was the international house at the UofA which got 29 of the meals. Five families from Richard Secord school were also served. We had 30 volunteers helping with food preparation and delivery. Many other hands made cookies and we had enough to give each person 4 homemade cookies. We had 12 turkeys donated, helping to keep the costs down. While this initiative is a lot of work, it's also a blessing to have so many people working together to bring light into someone's otherwise lonely Christmas
