Mission Moments

Climate change, conflict and COVID-19 have combined to create a global food crisis where 50 million people in 45 countries suffer from acute hunger. Presbyterian World Service & Development (PWS&D), with Canadian Foodgrains Bank and ACT Alliance, is responding in South Sudan, Pakistan, Yemen and Somalia, countries where hunger needs are worsening daily. This crisis has disproportionately adverse effects on women and girls, who make up 60% of those affected by food insecurity. Without

proper nutrition, women can experience higher mortality rates for themselves and their children. With support from the church, PWS&D distributes food packages with essential nourishing items and provides families with cash assistance, helping ensure that families are fed.



"Hamper sizes and number of boxes per client will be decreasing slightly. Supporters have been very kind and generous to the Organization and we appreciate it. In its history, Edmonton's FB has never seen the growth in demand and expectations that it experienced in 2022. More than 415,660 people were served by hamper programs in 2022. (In addition to the alarming growth in hamper requests, we are handling more requests for food for meal & snack programs. The current demand for our services is continuously outstripping our food donations. Edmonton's FB does not receive funding for food or operations on an ongoing basis. Nov 23, 2022, the Province announced that they were going to provide \$20M to Food Banks and civil society. Their recent allocation was \$5M of which we will be receiving \$280,000. This is the equivalent of one-month worth of food purchases for Edm's FB"
