## Mission Moments

When we give to Presbyterians Sharing, we express our faith, proclaiming God's love, hope and grace through the decisions we make and the actions we take. Together, we support congregations, theological colleges, camps, presbyteries, synods and specialized ministries as they nurture disciples and share our faith. We help leaders explore new models of ministry, and we help people experiencing barriers to traditional social engagement overcome them in innovative ways. Through mission staff and grants, we accompany 1 international mission partners. We live out God's call for justice by collaborating with ecumenical and interfaith partners to speak out against injustice, advocate for human rights and care for creation around the world. God does remarkable things with the gifts we give.

## The Easter Meal Collaboration Results!!!

- There were 129 meals made for delivery.
- We served about 50 people at the sit-down dinner.
- We made up about 30 meals from the leftovers, some of which were taken after the sit-down dinner and the rest are in the Greenfield freezer for whoever needs them
- There were 15 helpers in the kitchen and 7 drivers for delivery
- The total cost of the meal was \$ 998.76 (say 210 meals are \$4.76 each)
- Meals associated with Enjoy Life – 4 homes, 10 meals
- Meals associated with Dayspring – 12 houses, -
- 44 meals (28 of these were known to be from Food Bank clients)
- Meals associated with Greenfield – 7 homes, 12 meals
- International U of A students – 47 meals
- Community League meals – 5 houses, 16 meals

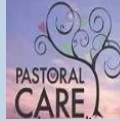
