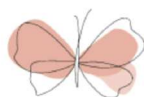

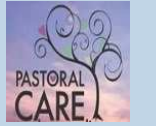

There's something for kids of all ages at the Presbyterian Church's own Camp Kannawin in July. See their website for more details and to register.

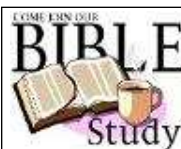
