The 'Tax preparation assistance program' for 2023 returns! To volunteer as a tax preparer, contact **Sam or Ali** at TaxTime@DayspringChurch.ca Training and other resources are available. They are looking to **start at the end of February or early March 2024**. Once there are enough volunteers, word will be spread that DPC can help prepare individual tax returns.

We have been approved for a grant of \$2,005. from the Community Volunteer Income Tax Program of the CRA to go towards our "Make Tax Time Pay" initiative. We are also continuing to call for

volunteers and would like to get responses before the end of December to give enough time for the volunteers to register with the CRA in time for the tax season in April.
