Please see Darlene Eerkes (Roll Clerk) or her designate if you are unsure of your DPC membership status. This is not a competitive election. Everyone is invited to vote with two forms of accounting occurring in the election:

The official ballot is an opportunity for all who are Professing Members of the congregation of DPC to indicate their support (or not) for the candidates. Voting members officially elect the Elders to Session.

The advisory ballot is an opportunity for all who are Adherents (not members but regular participants in the congregation) to indicate their support (or not) for the candidates.

Ballots may be completed by mail-in or in-person voting: In person ballot/voting will occur after the Worship Services on the 14 and 21. Voting will cease 30 minutes after the worship service on January 21, 2024.

Mailing/emailing in your vote using the official ballot form. The Administrative Assistant accepting this "mail" vote will be required to identify your name so we can recognize you as a professing member or adherent (advisory vote), so your vote will be registered in the correct tally.

Mission Moments: Sohdi became the sole provider for her family when her husband died a decade ago. A farmer in Pakistan, she plants various crops, but droughts and floods have disrupted food production for three years. In 2021, Sohdi received aid through the Humanitarian, Early Recovery and Development project, supported by PWS&D, which provided food aid to households in need. This assistance enabled her family to eat properly even during times of failed harvests. The project also provided support for women artisans to improve their skills and market

their goods, making them more resilient for the future. Sohdi is grateful for this support that allowed her to stay out of debt. Now, she dreams of her son's wedding as well as sending her other children to school.


