Some of the items will go to replenish DPC's food bank cupboard, but the majority will go right to the main food bank depot in Edmonton.

Main depot - requested items - beans without pork, canned fish or meat, baby formula, diapers, peanut butter (500g), healthy school snacks, soup, canned fruit or vegetables, pasta & pasta sauce, hot & cold cereal ... OR ... monetary donations.
