Mission Moments: The Pinuyumayan Church District, an Indigenous group of the Presbyterian Church in Taiwan, recently celebrated the publication of the first New Testament translated into their own language. The Pinuyumayan Bible translation team worked on the project for 8 years with the Rev. Dr. Paul McLean. Supported by Presbyterians Sharing, Paul works with 12 teams in Taiwan, preserving endangered Indigenous languages, promoting literacy, and when the Bible is read, proclaiming the Gospel.

As is our tradition at Dayspring, we will be collecting extra food bank items on **Thanksgiving Sunday**. If you'd like to participate, please bring non-perishable food items to donate and place them at the front of the sanctuary that morning. Some of the items will go to replenish DPC's food bank cupboard, but the majority will go right to the main food bank depot in Edmonton.



DPC's needed items - diapers, toilet paper, tea, instant coffee, powdered milk, pasta sauce, rice, school snacks for children

Main depot - requested items - beans without pork, canned fish or meat, baby formula, diapers, peanut butter (500g), healthy school snacks, soup, canned fruit or vegetables, pasta & pasta sauce, hot & cold cereal ... OR ... monetary donations.

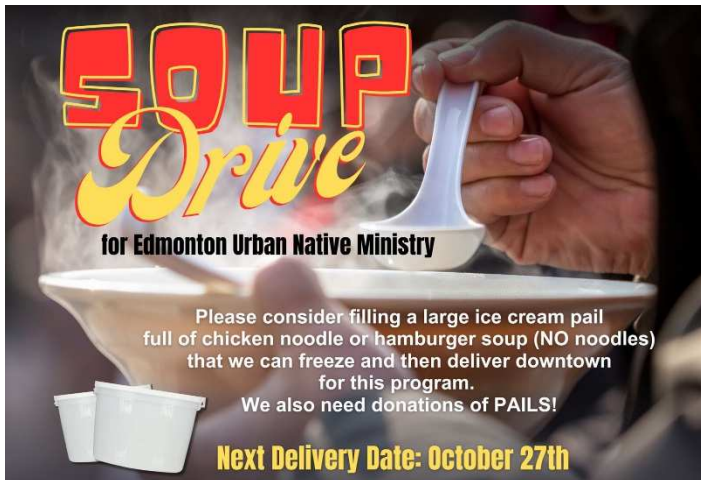
