Christmas isn't always Merry...a Church Service

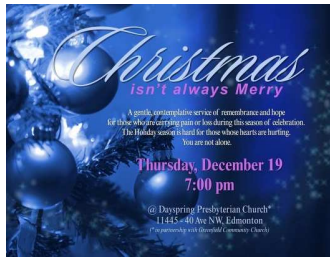
A Candlelight Christmas Service for anyone struggling this Christmas season or seeking a moment of calm reflection amidst a busy life.

Training and other resources are available. Most

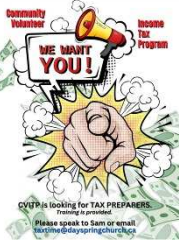
of the tax preparations will be done online,

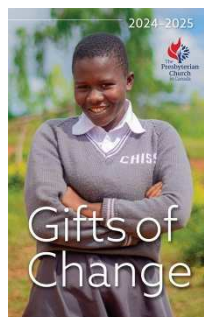
