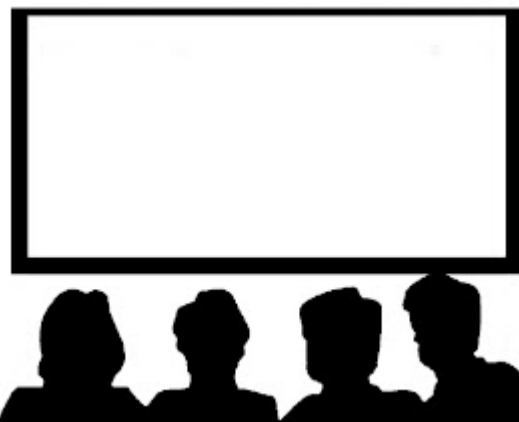
We'll bring a coffee cart into the sanctuary and then following the video there will be a brief time for questions/reactions.

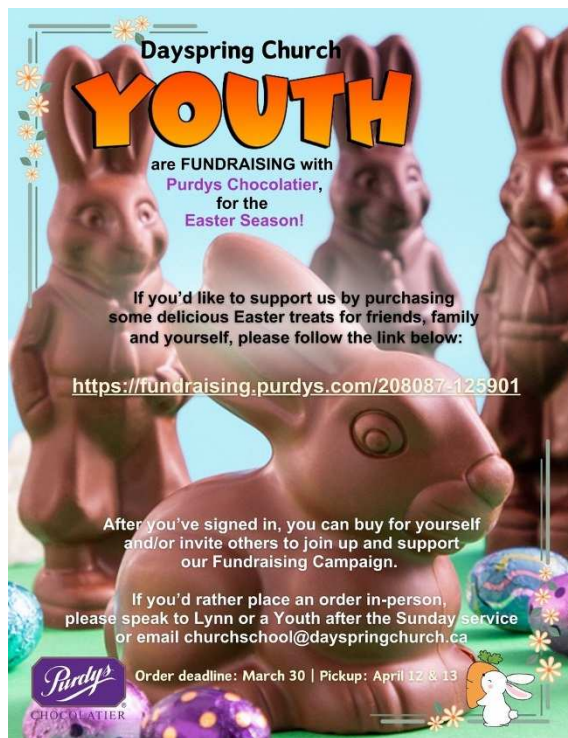
Mary-Jean B. has recently moved to St Joes hospital if you were looking to have a visit.

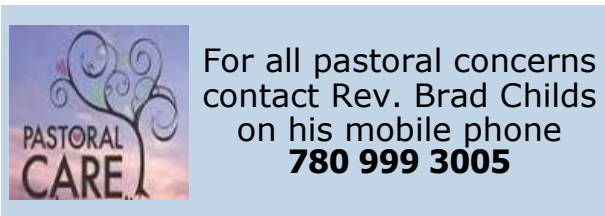
