Five years after getting married, Cristina's husband emigrated to the United States from Guatemala, leaving her in debt. Unable to pay off the debt, she lost her land and struggled to earn enough daily to feed her young children and repay the debt and interest. PWS&D's local partner. Cristina learned about healthy and nutritional diets

and was trained in how to manage her fields, family gardens and backyard animals. She also received financial support to raise livestock and grow vegetables.
