Presbyterians past and present, from coast to coast, have shared their memories and experiences of reconciliation, (in)justice, gathering, learning, ministry, mission, music, people and personalities, recreation and faith formation, buildings, and even some recipes from Presbyterian kitchens.

"I am grateful for the saints, past and present, who have made this project possible," says the editor of the publication, Ian McKechnie. "Their stories, their recollections, and their reflections speak to a church that has proclaimed Jesus Christ the same yesterday, today, and forever for 150 years and counting."

Recollections + Reflections will be formally launched at the 2025 General Assembly, taking place this year at McMaster University. Copies can also be ordered.

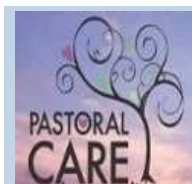
