The Presbyterian Church Heritage Centre (PCHC) has taken over the Sanctuary space at Carlisle United Church (formerly Presbyterian) in Carlisle, Ontario and the Grand Opening will be Sept 20, 2025. PCHC was formerly the National Presbyterian Museum. It will take time to organize all artefacts, books, and furniture, etc. in their special places. The 2021 General Assembly for the Presbyterian Church in Canada approved that the PCHC go forward with the "Our New Home Campaign" to raise \$200,000. They need individual and congregational support, they also need support from Presbyteries, Synods and organizations within our denomination across Canada. There will be a special donor wall for donations over \$1,000.
