other registrants and Team.

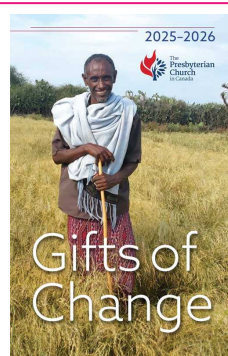
