Communities in Ghana are increasingly affected by the impacts of climate change. People with disabilities often face steeper barriers to education, health care and employment. PWS&D helps address these issues with our partner, the Garu Community-Based Rehabilitation (CBR) Program. Dominic Anane, who has a hearing impairment, was trained in climate-resilient breeding livestock through the CBR program. “The CBR and PWS&D are God sent. They supported me in engaging in agricultural production. This will help meet the livelihood needs of my family and get us out of poverty,” Domnic said.
