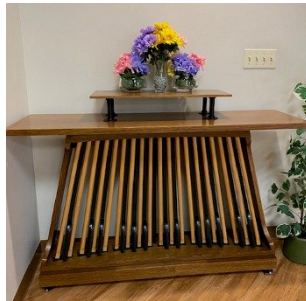


Partnering with CRA to have our Volunteers help others with their Tax Filing
