Note: Besides deaths and births, names are not included on this prayer list unless explicit permission is given.

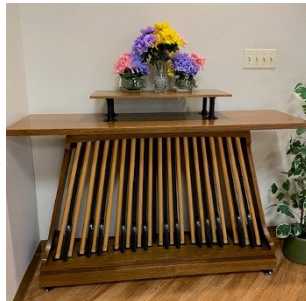


More Clean Up!!
