For more than 20 years, Kannawin has relied on a federal program called 'Canada Summer Jobs' to help hire our summer staff. Due to a number of federal budget changes, Kannawin did not receive the grant this year. We asked the Presbytery of the Northwest and the Presbytery of Calgary –Macleod whether they would consider replacing the grant for this year. We are grateful that both agreed to contribute \$25,000 each toward our staffing costs this summer. If you are able, any donation would go a long way this summer. The camp received a grant from the Presbyterian Church in Canada to replace the doors on the main building which offers added security, better insulation against the cold, and will keep our four-legged friends out. They also allow us to move toward electric locks, which will make rentals much easier and save money over time by reducing rekeying costs. Two furnaces gave out over the winter and will be replaced this summer, between the new furnaces and doors, we expect a drop in utility costs.
