After the Tigray peace agreement in Ethiopia, communities felt relief from violence, but many families continued to struggle. Ato, a farmer, lost all his household assets in the war, and his family ate once daily. When Ato's family participated in an agriculture and livelihoods program, he received training, seeds, goats and hand tools. Now he is growing healthy food for his household. The family's two goats had four kids, one of which the family sold to cover financial gaps. This program was supported by PWS&D and Canadian Foodgrains Bank, in collaboration with Tearfund.
